

Millions of children in India, particularly those living in impoverished urban and semi-urban areas, lack access to fundamental literacy education. This deprivation not only limits their individual growth but also hinders the overall development of their communities. In Muzaffarnagar and Noida, children in identified slum communities are currently at risk of being left behind. They lack essential learning materials, dedicated educators, and a conducive environment to foster their educational journey.

Iksha aims to start one literacy center each as an **annual continuous learning program** in Muzzafarnagar and Noida catering to **over 60+ students** with an aim to bring the light of learning and break the cycle of poverty and illiteracy.

# meet the teacher Roselin




Roselin is an M.A., and a B.Ed. under training who is sharing her time with a zeal to educate the underprivileged kids, given that she has had many challenges in her own life.
